Distinctly located on the second floor of Dove Healthcare-West, 1405 Truax Boulevard, residents residing in Reflections will receive specialized end-of-life care.

“Several employees, including our Chaplain, have been instrumental in developing a philosophy of care and creating an environment which supports dignified care using a holistic and interdisciplinary approach. This newly renovated unit is part of Dove Healthcare-West’s on-going commitment to provide a diverse range of health care services to meet the needs of the community.” said Rosemeyer.

All employees of Reflections receive advanced training in caring for terminally ill residents and they will support both resident and family with grief and bereavement counseling. The previously established “*No One Dies Alone*” program can provide the reassuring presence of a Volunteer Companion to residents who would otherwise be alone.

Nine private rooms are comfortably furnished to accommodate visiting family members and friends. Other features of the care unit include wireless internet, family lounge with complimentary refreshments, and a fully furnished family guest suite available at no charge for extended visits.
